

This pool is for use of members in good standing of Highland Creek Community Association

POOL RULES

- Lifeguards have the right to refuse pool privileges if pool rules are not followed or Association dues are not current
- Residents must present a valid Highland Creek Photo ID card for entry into the pool area (children under 5 years of age are not required to have an ID)
- Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty-trained must wear appropriate waterproof clothing when entering or being carried into the pool
- No one, regardless of age, may use the pool unless they are either (1) a strong and competent swimmer, or (2) are under the direct constant supervision of a strong competent swimmer
- ➤ Highland Creek residents with Association dues that are current may have up to 3 guests per Highland Creek ID card. Fees for local guests are \$5 per person.
- > Residents may obtain out-of-town guest passes at the Sports Club office
- > Pool guests must always be accompanied by a Highland Creek resident
- NO DIVING, RUNNING, PUSHING, OR HORSEPLAY is permitted in the pool area
- No towels, rafts, or large toys are permitted in the pool
- > No regulation sports balls are allowed in the pool area or within the pool
- Only basketballs provided by Highland Creek are permitted within the basketball hoop areas
- No profane or abusive language is permitted
- > No loud or inappropriate music is permitted in the pool area
- NO ALCOHOL is permitted in the pool area
- > NO SMOKING OR VAPING is permitted in the pool area
- NO GLASS is permitted in the pool area
- > NO PETS are permitted in the pool area
- > All children in the pool area must be supervised by an adult at all times
